SCHOOL PROFILE

The Malling School is situated in extensive grounds, which incorporate large playing fields and a lake. The school is close to the motorway system with the M20 nearby. From the motorway South London is a 25 minute drive.

The school is currently a mixed 11-18 school of 417 students, with an on-site Unit of 80 students with Speech, Language and Dyslexia difficulties.

New school:-

The school has been completely re-built as part of a PFI project. We were pleased to move in to the superb new buildings in September 2007. There are many innovative design features reflecting a "World Class School of the Future" approach.

OFSTED

The most recent inspection took place in May 2006, with the overall judgement being "**A GOOD SCHOOL**".



Almost all grades throughout the report are "**GOOD**" with the highest grade of "**OUTSTANDING**" reserved for the progress made by learners with learning difficulties". In this respect the team singled out the work of the school's Speech and Language Unit as being outstanding.



Curriculum

There are many successful areas within the school but in particular, Science is a Leading Department in Kent. The school is currently bidding for specialist schools status with specialism in Science, with Sport, supported by ICT. New initiatives include:-

Vertical Tutor Groups, Project Based Learning in year 7 and 8. Laptop scheme in year 7 and superb ICT

facilities throughout the new school.
